

Letter to Teacher

You will write a letter telling me about you. Please begin with **Dear Ms. Shelton** and end by signing your name. Be sure to make answers to each set of questions a new paragraph.

1. What are you like as a student? How do you usually behave as a student? How would you describe your personality?
2. How do you like to be treated? Be specific. How is it easiest to get along with you? What behavior in a teacher really bothers you? What behavior in a teacher really makes you want to learn?
3. Explain how you feel about reading out loud in class or presenting in front of others. Tell me about yourself as a reader. How often do you read? What type of materials do you really enjoy? (May be electronic)
4. Describe your writing/composing abilities. Do you consider yourself a good writer? What kinds of things do you like to write about? What are your strongest skills as a writer? What areas would you like to improve?
5. Thinking back as a student, what are your favorite activities or assignments? Explain why these were your favorites. (You must have at least two and they do not have to be from English classes.)
6. What would you like to accomplish in this class? Be specific. What part of the English class is your strongest area? (reading, writing, vocabulary, grammar, etc.)
7. What are your major interests, talents, skills, and/or hobbies? What are you proudest of that you have accomplished in your life? Who are you most proud of in your life? Who is most proud of you?
8. What can I do that will be most helpful or interesting for you? Is there any other information you feel I need to know about you? Do you have any questions for me?

This is your first writing grade that counts 40%. You will have three days to work on this in class in addition to your Eagle symbolism. The letter should be typed in 12 pt. times new roman with a heading that includes your name/my name (GRIFFIN)/the date/class period. This assignment and the Eagle are due Friday, August 31. Failure to meet this format criterion will result in points taken off.
